

## **The Black River Amateur Radio Club**

### **Sunday Evening Net Preamble**

“This is K8BRC, net control station for the Black River Amateur Radio Club Sunday Evening Net. This is <Your Call Sign> Control Operator. My name is <Your Name>. The purpose of this net is to disseminate information, promote fellowship, provide equipment checks and operator training.

This net meets every Sunday evening at 8:30 PM on the Black River Amateur Radio Club VHF Repeater. This net is open to all licensed radio amateurs, you need not be a member to participate. If there is Emergency or Priority Traffic, feel free to break in at any time.

The Repeater operates on 147.360 MHz with a 600 kHz plus offset and a 94.8 Hz Tone. Should the VHF Repeater be off the air, the net will operate on the Black River Amateur Radio Club UHF repeater. The UHF repeater operates on 444.300 mHz, with a 5 mHz plus offset and a 94.8 Hz tone. If both repeaters are off the air, the net will operate on 146.550 mHz simplex.

- Arrange/Assign Net control for next week
